#1 Pair a child with a peer who can act as a helper. Peers can be great sources of support!




#2 Provide visuals to increase likelihood of child's participation and compliance to routine




#3 Break down tasks or activities into smaller, more manageable parts so that child is not overwhelmed



#4 Stabilise materials, such as paper, to the table using tape, fabric-strip fasteners, or non-skid backing



#5 Make materials larger or brighter to attract attention or interest



#6 Incorporate a favourite toy into a specific area or activity to encourage participation in new activities
