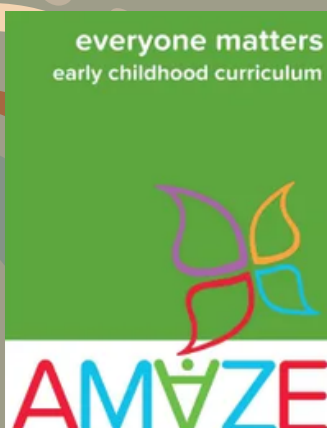
Demonstrate self-awareness, confidence, family pride and positive social identities

Recognise unfairness, have language to describe unfairness and understand unfairness hurts



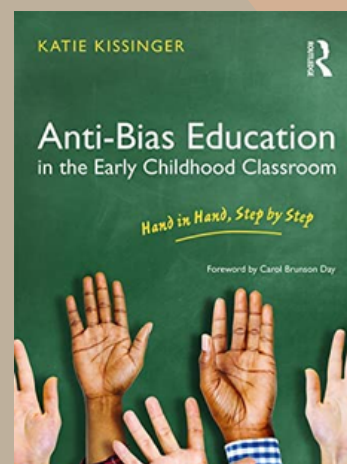
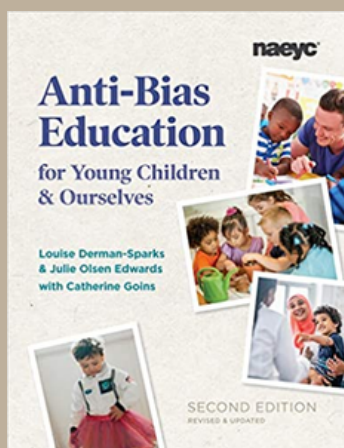
AMAZEworks Early Childhood Curriculum
